After enrollment, mature students take the same classes under the same conditions as enrollees selected under different admission systems. There is no special curriculum for mature students.

Number of Students retained (Undergraduate): ICU does not set a curriculum for each year (with the exception of language instruction courses). During the time from enrollment to graduation, each student actively selects courses in order to acquire the 136 units necessary for graduation while taking important matters into account. Therefore, there is no "holding back" of students. In addition, Students must complete 4 years of study. Students must complete their studies in no more than 8 years.
