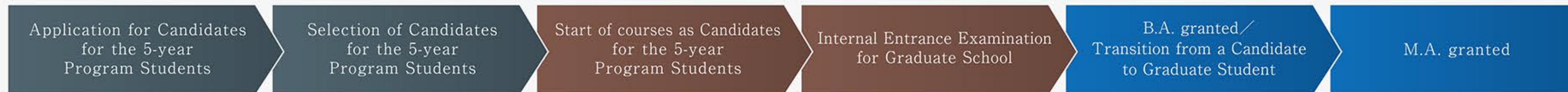


# Flowchart of the 5-year Program



## To be “Candidates for the 5-year Program Students”

### ■ Application Requirements

- 1) GPA: 3.20 or higher at the end of the second term of the junior year. Or 3.40 or higher for courses in the 200s or above.
- 2) UNITS: Less than 26 units of CLA courses remaining, including senior thesis, at the end of the third term of the junior year.
- 3) Application Documents: Research Plan, Letter of Recommendation

**GPA** | Grade Point Average / Calculated by dividing the sum of the “grade points” earned by the total number of units taken.

Those planning to join a study abroad program can also apply. Please contact the Graduate School Group for detailed information.

### ■ Selection

- 1) Selection Methods: Documentary screening
- 2) Application Period: Third term of the junior year (April Students - December) (September Students - April)
- 3) Application Documents: Application Form, Research Plan, A Letter of Recommendation\*

\*Written by the advisor, or the expected senior thesis advisor.

## After becoming “Candidates for the 5-year Program Students”

### ■ Taking GS Courses (as Credit Auditor)

- 1) GPA: 3.20 or higher
  - 2) Units: Up to 10 units\*
  - 3) Term: Senior year of CLA
- \*The units acquired as a Credit Auditor cannot be counted as a unit of undergraduate.

## Internal Entrance Examination for Graduate School

### ■ Application Requirements

- 1) GPA: 3.20 or higher at the end of the first term of the senior year. Or 3.40 or higher for courses in the 200s or above.

### ■ Entrance Examination

- 1) Selection Methods: Documentary screening and oral interview
- 2) Application Period: Summer Vacation of the senior year (April Student - August) The second term of the senior year (September students - February)
- 3) Application Documents: Application Form, Research Plan, Summary of Research Plan in English, Letter of Recommendation

## Graduation from CLA

- Submission of Senior Thesis (Third term of the senior year)  
Students will gain their bachelor's degree by acquiring the designated units / GPA, and submitting their senior thesis.

## Entrance of Graduate School

- Candidacy for the Degree of Master of Arts (First term of the first year of GS)
  - 1) GPA: 3.00 or higher
  - 2) Units: 18 units\*

\*The total units including the units acquired as a Credit Auditor (10 units max)
- Preparing the Master's Thesis

## Graduation from GS

- Submission of Master's Thesis (Third term of the first year of GS)
- Units Acquired
  - 1) GPA: 3.00 or higher
  - 2) Units: 30 units

Students will gain their master's degree by acquiring the designated units / GPA, and submitting their master's thesis.
