Announcement of Teaching Position in health/sport science, leisure/recreational studies, outdoor/experiential education, and/or physical education

Outline	International Christian University (ICU) is a private, bilingual university that provides a first-class liberal arts education in a culturally and religiously diverse international community of students, faculty and staff. ICU's educational mission is based on Christian and democratic principles. ICU has approximately 3,000 students and over 150 faculty members from Japan and overseas. The university is located on a wooded campus in the suburbs of Tokyo. We are pleased to announce an open search for a full-time teaching position (contractual appointment) in the Health and Physical Education Program (HPE) with a particular focus on fields related to health/sport science, leisure/recreational studies, outdoor/experiential education, and/or physical education. The successful applicant is expected to teach health science and physical education exercise courses in the Health and Physical Education Program, the College of Liberal Arts. Full-time HPE academic staff members shall teach 12 class periods (in principle, including 1 lecture, 9 exercise, 2 group or individual tutorials) per week. The successful applicant is expected to teach HPE courses as well as to support management of the PE program and PE facilities, and to support students' extracurricular activities.

Qualifications	1. The candidate must have a Master's degree, or have equivalent research contribution and have competence to teach in his/her specialized field. 2. The candidate must be able to teach exercise courses in Japanese and in English, and teach lecture courses in Japanese. (The ability to teach lecture courses in English is desirable.) 3. The candidate should have a good understanding of liberal arts education. 4. Previous teaching experience at a university or other educational institutions (e.g., elementary, middle, or high school) is desirable.
